There were updates given by Stokes regarding past and upcoming events and efforts including the BBQ Competition & Festival, Unity in the Community Forum, Cole Camp Walking/Historic Tour, Visitor Center and Master Plan, Whiteman BCC Council and Whiteman 509 Comm Squadron Change of Command, Creating Entrepreneurial Communities (2022 in Hermann) and hosting site in 2023 of Benton County, State Fair shared booth with the MO Division of Tourism (8/17), Big BAM literature sent, new tourism brochure, new tourism video(s), MO Humanities Featured Five Communities, Cole Camp Pumpkinfest, change of date for Warsaw fireworks to 8/5, Benton County BBQ Festival and marketing ads update.

Osage Lakes Greenway Updates were given by Stokes regarding the inactivity of the OLGC 501©3 organization. Motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Kendall to dissolve the OLGC for the \$25 fee versus re-instating it for \$450. Motion was unanimously approved.
